NOTICE TO PURCHASERS OF USED MATERIALS: This agreement **does not apply** to purchasers of this course from previous users or from “second-hand bookstores.” Missing items from any course will not be supplied by the publisher if the course was not purchased directly from the publisher or from a retailer.

1. **License:** The materials that accompany this license are protected by copyright law. This license governs any revisions or updates that may be provided for you. **This agreement must always be a part of the course, even if the course is sold as used material.** Your rights and obligations with respect to the use of materials are as follows.

You may:
